




Building blocks

Look at the buildings below. How many cubes, spheres, cylinders or pyramids are used to make each one? Write your answers next to them.








Extra challenge!

Make a paper net of the cube shape. Copy the diagram on a piece of paper, cut it out, fold and glue the tabs together to make a cube.





Answers: Top left 10 cubes, 3 pyramids, 3 spheres. Top right 5 cubes, 3 spheres, 1 pyramid (total assumes there are 4 pink cubes on the bottom layer – only 3 are visible!)
